## **Udall Foundation 2026 Education Programs Eligibility Criteria**

## Udall Undergraduate Scholarship Eligibility

- 1) Environmental Category:
  - a. U.S. Citizens, Nationals, and Lawful Permanent Residents;
  - b. Who are sophomore or junior-level students of accredited higher education institutions;
  - c. Who intend to pursue careers related to the environment; and
  - d. Who meet other appropriate eligibility requirements set by the Udall Foundation.
- 2) Native American and Alaska Native Categories:
  - a. U.S. Citizens, Nationals, and Lawful Permanent Residents;
  - b. Who are enrolled members of one or more Federally Recognized Indian Tribes that are included in the <u>annual list of Indian Tribes</u> published by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to 25 U.S.C. § 5131;
  - c. Who intend to pursue careers in health care or Tribal public policy; and
  - d. Who meet other appropriate eligibility requirements set by the Udall Foundation.

## Native American Congressional Internship Eligibility

- 1) U.S. Citizens, Nationals, and Lawful Permanent Residents;
- 2) Who are enrolled members of one or more Federally Recognized Indian Tribes that are included in the <u>annual list of Indian Tribes</u> published by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to 25 U.S.C. § 5131;
- Who are current students or recent graduates of accredited higher education institutions;
  and
- 4) Who meet other appropriate eligibility requirements set by the Udall Foundation.

## Morris K. Udall and John S. McCain III Native American Graduate Fellowship in Tribal Policy Eligibility

- 1) U.S. Citizens, Nationals, and Lawful Permanent Residents;
- 2) Who are enrolled members of one or more Federally Recognized Indian Tribes that are included in the <u>annual list of Indian Tribes</u> published by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to 25 U.S.C. § 5131;
- 3) Who are current graduate students of accredited higher education institutions;
- 4) Who intend to pursue advanced degrees in health care; and
- 5) Who meet other appropriate eligibility requirements set by the Udall Foundation.
